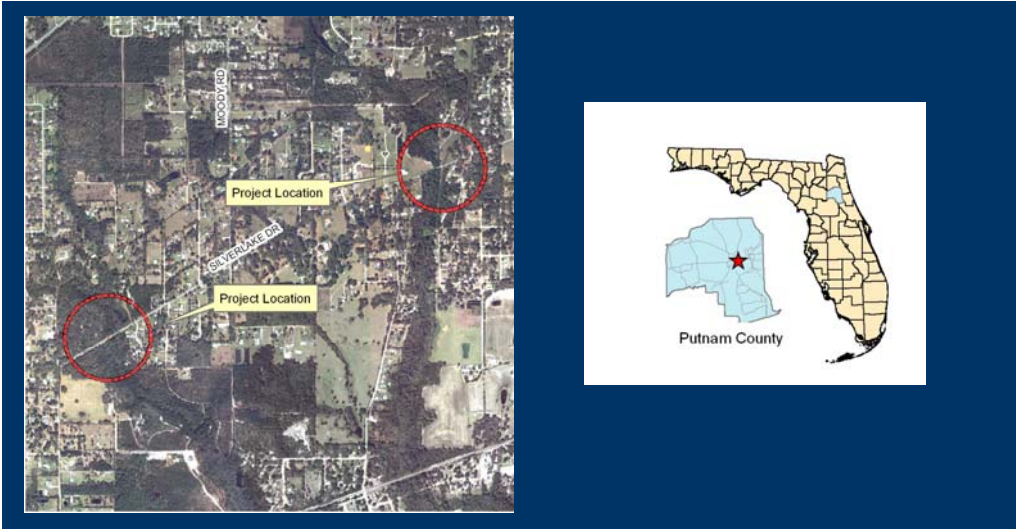


# Transportation Improvements – Florida at Work

At Devall Branch and Two Mile Creek

### Project Summary

The drainage pipes over Devall Branch and Two Mile Creek will be completely replaced with box culverts.

**Traffic Impacts:** In order for the new box culverts to be built, the road will be completely closed the construction. The contractor plans to begin work first on the Devall Branch location which will take approximately four months. Another detour will be in place once the construction moves to Two Mile Creek.

**Detour Route for the Devall Branch Improvements:** Old Peniel Road to Moody Road back to Silver Lake Drive



**Contractor:** AWA Contracting Company, Inc., of Jacksonville is the main contractor hired by Putnam County.

**Funded by:** American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (federal economic stimulus funding)
